

### Post-training workshop: Estimating the danger for suicide (3.5 hours)

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This workshop is an English language version of *Consolider ses apprentissages pour mieux prévenir le suicide: un atelier de perfectionnement à la formation Intervenir auprès de la personne suicidaire à l'aide de bonnes pratiques*. It is offered to participants who have successfully completed the training **Best practices in suicide intervention** or its French language equivalent, **Intervenir auprès de la personne suicidaire à l'aide de bonnes pratiques**. It is designed to help practitioners build on the skills they learned in this training, to provide an opportunity to improve clinical judgement, and to provide a space to ask questions about suicide that are specific to their practice. It is available in both English and French.

#### OUTLINE OF THE WORKSHOP

- Brief review of how to use the *Estimation tool for suicide danger* and its scoring guide
- In-depth discussion of new case studies (estimation and clinical issues). Case studies may be provided by the client or by Suicide Action Montreal.
- Question period on the estimation of danger for suicide and the management of suicidal behaviour.

#### ORGANIZING A GROUP

- The length of the workshop will be determined by the objectives set, the number of cases studied, and the needs of the participants. The most common format is 3.5 hours.
- The number of participants per group is determined by the objectives of the workshop and the profile of the group. Most groups have a maximum of 15 people.
- All participants must have successfully completed *Best practices in suicide intervention* or its French language equivalent, *Intervenir auprès de la personne suicidaire à l'aide de bonnes pratiques*.
